Time: 10:00 am to 12:00 pm

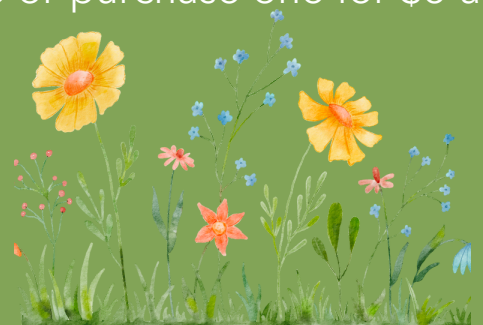
Location: Little Sparrow Flower Farm

This 27-acre family farm is located in rural Loudon, TN and is proudly dedicated to provide fresh and lush chemical free flowers and herbs for the surrounding communities.

A variety of spring flowers (Peonies, Ranunculus, Lavender, Yarrow, and Mountain Mint to name a few) and foliage buckets will be available to choose from to make your own arrangements.
